BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Ralph K. Patton was a B-17 pilot in World War II who was shot down over France after completing a successful mission to bomb a German fighter base on Jan. 5, 1944. Mr. Patton and surviving members of his crew parachuted into the Brittany peninsula, where they were rescued and sheltered for the next two and a half months by members of the French resistance until the British Military Intelligence Service could rescue them.

Mr. Patton made multiple trips to France in the following years in an effort to find and thank the people who risked their lives to help him and his fellow airmen. In 1964, to preserve the legacy of their bravery, he co-founded the Air Forces Escape and Evasion Society (AFEES). The organization recognizes those who helped aviators who were shot down in France, Belgium, and Holland during World War II. Mr. Patton was president of AFEES for 27 years until 1991, overseeing the growth of the organization to 680 members during his tenure. Ralph Patton donated many of his personal records and books, along with those of the AFEES, to the US Air Force Academy in multiple batches between 1993 and 2009. Mr. Patton died on January 31, 2011 at his home in Bethesda, Maryland at the age of 90.

Madame Anne Brusselmans, who is also covered extensively in this collection, started her underground activities in 1940 by translating messages from the BBC radio network into French. She then provided assistance to Allied servicemen trapped in German-occupied territory after the invasion of Belgium in May 1940. From 1941 through September 1944, she sheltered and provided false identity papers to more than 130 Allied airmen shot down behind enemy lines. She was a member of a resistance group that operated an escape route that stretched from Belgium, across France, and over the Pyrenees Mountains to Madrid, Spain, and ending in the British territory of Gibraltar. When Brussels was liberated on September 3, 1944, Madame Brusselmans was protecting 54 airmen. Her many decorations for valor and wartime heroism include: Knight of the Order of Leopold II, Croix de Guerre, Medal of Resistance, Medal of Voluntary Combatant, Medal of Military Information, Medal of Europe, a citation from the Federation of Allied Forces in Europe, the American Medal of Freedom with Silver Palm, and the Polish Medal of Resistance. Anne Brusselmans died on June 29, 1993 at the age of 88.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

MS 54 consists of primary and secondary source materials regarding the escape and evasion of Allied military members from Nazi forces in occupied Europe during World War II. It also contains items provided by the Air Forces Escape and Evasion Society (AFEES), which was co-founded by Ralph K. Patton in 1964 to document wartime experiences and reunite Allied fighters with the local underground resistance members who aided them.

In all, the collection contains 71 boxes of materials that were donated to Clark Special Collections on nine separate occasions between 1994 and 2009. They are divided between the primary collection and eight separate addendums to maintain their original order and preserve the context in which they were donated. Each addendum has its own *Scope and Content Note* providing a brief explanation of its contents and its own *Arrangement and Description* of the included materials.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of six boxes divided into three series, outlined below. There are also multiple addendums to this collection, each with their own Scope and Content Notes.

SERIES ONE: ANNE BRUSSELMANS

Consists of topical files pertaining to the resistance activities of Madame Anne Brusselmans.

SERIES TWO: MANUSCRIPTS

Consists of two unpublished manuscripts that pertain to escape and evasion during World War II.

SERIES THREE: PUBLICATIONS

Consists of a series of books acquired by Ralph Patton, which pertain to escape and evasion during World War II.
