SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This manuscript collection consists of eighteen boxes of materials collected by Robin C, Janton for his book, The Two Squadrons That Were One: The 859th and 788th Bombardment Squadrons, England, World War II, in 2003, and the second edition revision in 2005. Mr. Janton was born, 22 Sep 1942, in Columbus, Ohio, and served in the army as a ranger in the 1st Cavalry Division (Airmobile) and the 2nd Infantry Division in Korea from 1964-1968. After leaving the army, Mr. Janton owned and operated a sporting goods store until 1979. In 1987, Mr. Janton became a non-denomination minister. Mr. Janton's interest in these squadrons arose from the fact that Mr. Janton's father served as a crew chief with these units. The collection is arranged into (9) series. The manuscript collection was indexed and ordered by Mr. Janton. The order of series has been changed for research purposes but the order within each series remains in the same order as Mr. Janton intended.

SERIES ONE: PERSONNEL, consists of files on the various units within the 859th and 788th Bomb Squadrons that served in England during World War II. All personnel in these units are identified to the best of Mr. Janton's ability and include individual photographs, and correspondence from individuals helping Mr. Janton to identify individuals in photographs.

SERIES TWO: TOPICAL FILES, consists of Flight Records, Casualty Reports, Fuel Logs, and other information used by Mr. Janton in his research for his book. Also included are files pertaining to citations and medals awarded to various members of these two Bombardment Squadrons during World War II.

SERIES THREE: DIARIES AND NARRATIVES, consists of diaries and photocopies of diaries and narratives, pertaining to events that occurred during the formation, training, being in combat, and return to the United States by various air crews and individuals in the 859th and 788th Bombardment Squadrons.

SERIES FOUR: PHOTOGRAPHS, consists of photographs and negatives used by Mr. Janton for inclusion in his book. The photographs are calendared by donor.

SERIES FIVE: CORRESPONDENCE, consists of research between Mr. Janton and various Air Force historians concerning his research into the 859th and 788th Bombardment Squadrons in

England during World War II. The series is calendared in the order Mr. Janton intended rather than alphabetically.

SERIES SIX: NEWSLETTERS, consists of newsletters and reunion information from the two bomb squadrons and the 8th Air Force. Also included are newsletters from various units not included in Mr. Janton's research.

SERIES SEVEN: MICROFILM, consists of 16 mm microfilm pertaining to Mr. Janton's research from the Air Force History Office, Maxwell, AL. The boxes of film are not identified except by the identity number provided by Maxwell Air Force History Office.

SERIES EIGHT: ARTIFACTS, consists of a World War II poster mounted on cardboard, and two decks of playing cards. One deck is from the 8th Air Force Museum in Savannah, Georgia, and the other deck of cards is one of the decks of cards used in Operation "Iraqi Freedom" in 2003.

SERIES NINE: MISCELLANEOUS, consists of materials gathered by Mr. Janton which do not pertain to his research on the 859th and 788th Bombardment Squadrons. Topics include the attack at Pearl Harbor, other units in World War II, and Vietnam.
